Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$391 and \$840** is inside the band where half of all Ford F-150 ball joint replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (one serviceable lower joint on a truck, alignment skipped); above it is not automatically gouging (both sides upper and lower, joints integral to the control arm, alignment included) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Serviceable or not** — on many vehicles the joint comes only with the whole control arm.
- **One side or both** — worn joints tend to fail in pairs; shops often recommend both sides.
- **Alignment** — ball joints set the geometry — an alignment belongs on the same invoice.

Vehicle **Ford F-150, model years 1978–2023**
Data confidence **High** — *large sample, stable ranges*
Records through **July 2026**, refreshed continuously
Source **paid invoices from independent US repair shops**

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.

NOT A QUOTE This report describes what other owners paid for the same repair. Your year, engine, region and the parts chosen shift the number. FixDozer does not perform repairs and receives nothing from shops.

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
