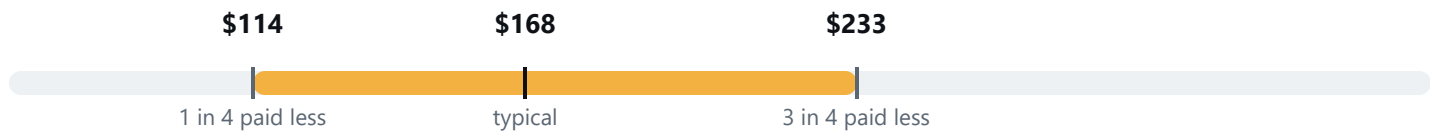

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$114 and \$233** is inside the band where half of all Honda Accord relay replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (a plug-in relay in the fuse box); above it is not automatically gouging (a relay integrated into a module, or a corroded connector repaired) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Diagnosis is the value** — the part is cheap; proving the relay is the cause (not the component it feeds) is the work.
- **Integrated relays** — some are built into a module that must be replaced whole.

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
