Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$253 and \$528** is inside the band where half of all Ford F-350 fuel filter replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (single inline filter on a gasoline engine); above it is not automatically gouging (diesel primary and secondary filters, filter housing replaced, priming a hard-to-bleed system) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Gas vs. diesel** — diesel trucks run two filters at diesel-part prices.
- **Housing** — cracked or leaking filter housings add real cost.
- **Location** — in-tank filters mean tank work — a different job entirely.

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
