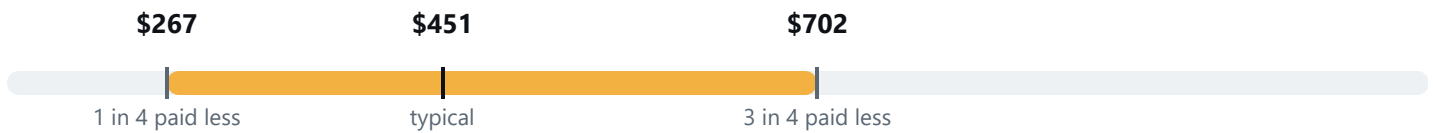

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$267 and \$702** is inside the band where half of all Ford F-150 ignition coil replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (a single coil on top of the engine); above it is not automatically gouging (a full set of coils with new plugs, rear-bank coils under the intake on V6 engines) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **One or a set** — coils fail one at a time, but a set at high mileage avoids repeat visits.
- **Plugs with it** — worn plugs kill coils — they usually get replaced together.
- **Access** — rear-bank coils on transverse V6 engines can mean removing the intake.

Vehicle **Ford F-150, model years 1984–2023**
Data confidence **High** — *large sample, stable ranges*
Records through **July 2026**, refreshed continuously
Source **paid invoices from independent US repair shops**

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
