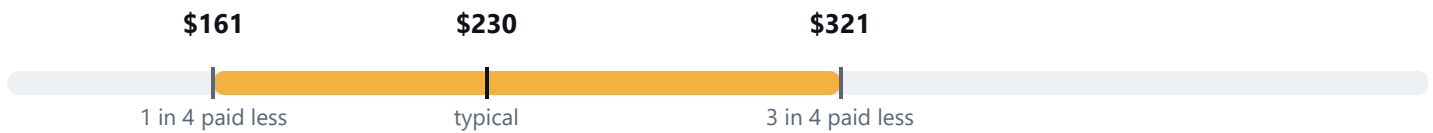

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$161 and \$321** is inside the band where half of all Ford Escape brake hose replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (one hose, single-corner bleed); above it is not automatically gouging (both hoses on an axle, seized fittings, a full fluid flush) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **One or a pair** — hoses age together; front hoses are often done as a pair.
- **Seized fittings** — rusted line nuts turn a quick job into line work.
- **Fluid flush** — old dark fluid is usually flushed while the system is open.

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
