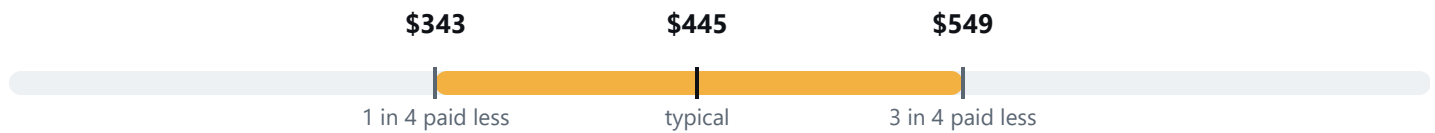

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$343 and \$549** is inside the band where half of all Honda Accord distributor replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (cap and rotor refresh only); above it is not automatically gouging (complete distributor with sensor, plugs and wires replaced, timing set with a light) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Cap-and-rotor vs. the whole unit** — a refresh is cheap; a complete distributor with its sensor is the expensive end.
- **Tune-up items** — plugs and wires are often replaced at the same time on these older engines.

Data confidence **Good** — *good sample, dependable ranges*
Records through **July 2026**, refreshed continuously
Source **paid invoices from independent US repair shops**

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.

NOT A QUOTE This report describes what other owners paid for the same repair. Your year, engine, region and the parts chosen shift the number. FixDozer does not perform repairs and receives nothing from shops.
