Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

### IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$555 and \$1,350** is inside the band where half of all Ford F-350 fuel injector replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (one gasoline injector on an accessible rail); above it is not automatically gouging (a full set, diesel injectors requiring coding, intake manifold removal to reach them) — but both ends deserve a question.

### WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Gas vs. diesel** — diesel injectors cost several times more and must be coded to the engine.
- **One or all** — shops often recommend replacing a set at high mileage.
- **Access** — some engines need the intake manifold off.

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
