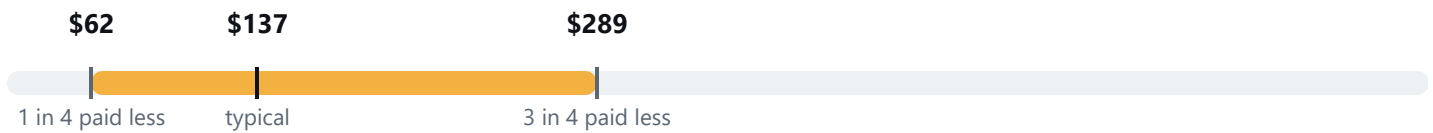

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$62 and \$289** is inside the band where half of all Ford F-150 light assembly replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (a bolt-in tail light on an older vehicle); above it is not automatically gouging (LED tail assembly, bumper-mounted units needing cover removal, both sides for matching) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **LED or bulb** — LED assemblies are sealed units and cost far more.
- **Access** — bumper-mounted lights may need the cover off.

Vehicle **Ford F-150, model years 1919–2024**

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
