Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$448 and \$1,036** is inside the band where half of all Toyota Camry strut replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (aftermarket loaded struts, alignment skipped); above it is not automatically gouging (OEM struts, all four corners, alignment included, sway-bar links replaced while apart) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Loaded vs. bare** — pre-assembled struts cost more in parts, less in labor.
- **One axle or both** — the typical job is one axle.
- **Alignment** — struts set the geometry — expect it on the invoice.

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
