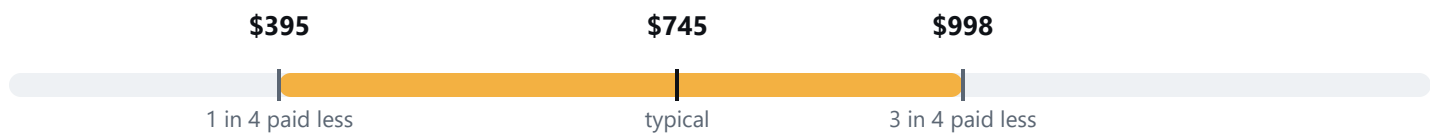

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$395 and \$998** is inside the band where half of all Ford Ranger clutch replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (standard kit with the flywheel resurfaced, two-wheel-drive layout); above it is not automatically gouging (dual-mass flywheel replaced, all-wheel-drive or subframe-drop vehicles, slave cylinder and hydraulics renewed) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Flywheel** — resurfacing is cheap; a dual-mass flywheel replacement is not.
- **Drivetrain layout** — AWD and transverse layouts take far longer to pull the transmission.
- **Hydraulics** — slave cylinders are usually replaced while the transmission is out.

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
