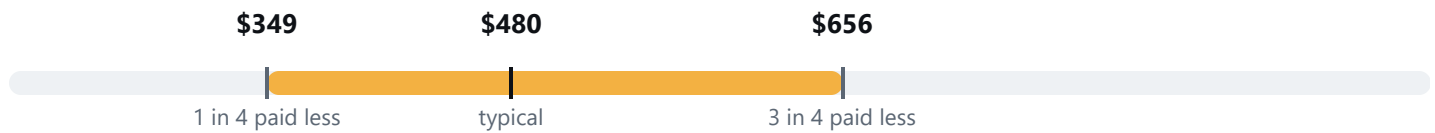

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$349 and \$656** is inside the band where half of all Ford F-150 water pump replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (belt-driven pump in the open, coolant topped up); above it is not automatically gouging (timing-belt-driven pump (belt job at the same time), thermostat and hoses renewed) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Belt-driven or timing-driven** — a pump behind the timing belt is a timing-belt job — the biggest price fork here.
- **While it's drained** — thermostat and hoses are often renewed.

Vehicle **Ford F-150, model years 1977–2023**

Data confidence **High** — *large sample, stable ranges*

Records through **July 2026**, refreshed continuously

Source **paid invoices from independent US repair shops**

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
