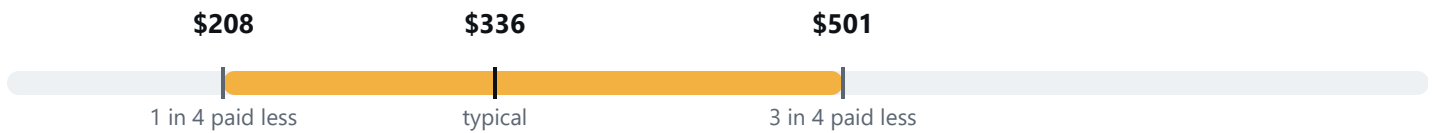

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$208 and \$501** is inside the band where half of all Ford F-150 blower motor replacements landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (resistor only, motor reused); above it is not automatically gouging (motor plus controller, dash disassembly on vehicles where it hides deep, rodent damage cleaned out) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Motor vs. resistor** — a blower that works only on high usually needs the resistor, not the motor.
- **Access** — most are behind the glovebox; a few need real dash work.
- **Cabin filter** — a clogged filter loads the motor — it usually gets replaced too.

Vehicle **Ford F-150, model years 1977–2022**

Source **paid invoices from independent US repair shops**

Bring it to the shop. Ask for the written estimate split into parts, labor hours and rate, and fees — then compare each line. A shop that explains a number above the range is doing its job; one that won't is telling you something too.
