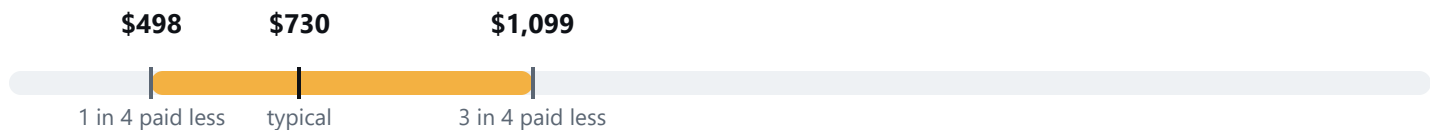

Low / typical / high are computed per line, so they don't add up exactly to the totals — the total row is the real distribution of complete invoices.

IS YOUR QUOTE FAIR?

A quote between **\$498 and \$1,099** is inside the band where half of all Chevrolet Silverado 1500 transfer case repairs landed. Below it is not automatically a bargain (fluid service and a seal, or a shift motor); above it is not automatically gouging (a remanufactured transfer case, driveshafts removed for access) — but both ends deserve a question.

WHAT MOVES THE PRICE

- **Part or unit** — shift motors and seals are modest; a replacement case is the expensive end.
- **Fluid** — the right transfer-case fluid is specific and often overlooked.
